

Course Commitments: AMI Orientation Certificate Course

The AMI Orientation Certificate Course is designed to enable the participant to develop an understanding of the basic Montessori principles underlying the Montessori Approach to Education.

The AMI Orientation Certificate Course comprises 30 hours online plus approximately 30 hours of independent study. Plus 9 hours of observation tasks.

In order to obtain the AMI Orientation Certificate Course, the following requirements must be fulfilled:

- A minimum of 90% attendance is required for all lectures and sessions during the stipulated online and offline hours. The orientation course is delivered fully online, and cameras must be on at all times during online sessions; otherwise, the participant will be marked absent.
- Submission of 3 essays (min. 500 words each) chosen from the topics designated; each reflecting a basic understanding of the chosen topic.
- Completion of 9 hours of Child Observation and submission of the notes and summaries taken during the observations following the given guidelines. Completion of material making as undertaken during the course.
- The AMI Orientation Certificate Course will be sent to the participant once all the assignments have been submitted and assessed; providing that the participant has the required minimum attendance.
- The AMI Oreintation Course is delivered fully online. (Guidelines Apply)
